To foster an understanding of the Labor movement's vital contributions to this nation's economic, social and political fabric.

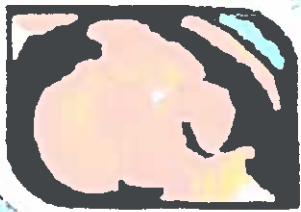
SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY
